General Lester L. Lyles is the former Commander of the Air Force Materiel Command, headquartered at Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio. The Command was responsible for all research and development, science and technology, test, and logistics support for the U.S. Air Force. He has commanded The Ogden Air Logistics Center at Hill AFB, Utah and the Air Force Space and Missile Development Center in Los Angeles. He was also the Director of the Ballistic Missile Defense Office and served as the 27th Vice Chief of Staff of the Air Force.

After his retirement from the Air Force after 35 years of service, he served on The President's Commission on U.S. Space Policy, and chairs the Rationale and Goals of the U.S. Civil Space Program Committee of the United States National Academies. General Lyles was named to the Review of U.S. Human Space Flight Committee by President Obama in 2009. The committee, also known as the "Augustine Committee" after its chairman Norman Augustine, presented its initial recommendations to the President in September.

His numerous awards include the Defense Distinguished Service Medal; the Astronautics Engineer of the Year from the National Space Club; the National Black Engineer of the Year Award; Honorary Doctor of Laws from New Mexico State University; and NASA's Distinguished Public Service Medal.
